

Submission to Plan Melbourne Refresh Discussion Paper – October 2015



Our Eastern Districts Polish Association property at 1325 Stud Road, Rowville is in a small precinct that is excluded from the Urban Growth Boundary for no apparent reason or logic. We have for many years been advised by local and state government representatives our land would be included within the UGB but this has not happened. Whilst our association intends to maintain its presence on the site we have a substantial amount of surplus land that could well be used for residential infill development. We respectfully ask that Plan Melbourne Refresh be redrafted so that the area of land our site sits in is included within the UGB. We understand Knox City Council recently resolved to make a submission in this regard and we support that submission
